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Subject: RFT AM-13563 for Provision of Technical Assistance for Interim National Water Resources Master Plan and National Water Resources Assessment – Cambodia

Question 1:

Is there any indicative budget available for the Fixed Scope component?

Answer 1:

Tenderers are expected construct an approach to achieve the fixed scope, which must include the level of effort and all associated costs within the budget form. For the conditional scope the Tenderer is expected to provide their approach and the personnel rates for any additional staff, expertise, or partners needed in addition to the fixed scope. A full budget for the conditional scope is not required and will be negotiated when approved.

Question 2:

Will office space and facilities be provided, or would the team be expected to be hosted within MOWRAM?

Answer 2:

No, the tenderer should plan for, and identify, the facilities required in their approach to meet the scope.

Question 3:

What other facilities or support will be provided (e.g. transport, administrative support, logistics assistance, etc.)?

Answer 3:

ACP4Climate will not provide logistics support, however, the program will support on coordination where appropriate. All logistics and administration costs should be considered in the budget.

Question 4:

Should we include a budget allowance for ad hoc support to MOWRAM?

Answer 4:

This is at the discretion of the tenderer, on the basis of their proposal to support MOWRAM.

Question 5:

Should stakeholder workshops and training costs be included in our proposal budget (e.g. travel, venue hire, catering, per diems, and related expenses)?

Answer 5:

Yes, all associated costs to achieve the proposed approach must be included.

Question 6:

To enable Tenderers to design a fit-for-purpose consultative and analytical process across both scopes, could ACP4Climate provide guidance on the expected scale of investment? Specifically:

- a) An indicative budget range for the Fixed Scope (foundational assessment, frameworks, Interim Water Master Plan) and, separately, the Conditional Scope (NWRA methodology, modelling, and finalisation); or
- b) Where a budget range cannot be shared, comparable ACP4Climate or precedent procurements that Tenderers may use as a reference for scale and effort.

Answer 6:

As per our response to Question 1 in this Addendum, Tenderer's are expected to construct an approach to deliver the services adequately. The budget should reflect the level of effort necessary to deliver the requirements of the fixed scope.

Comparable procurements will not be shared to guide tenderers.
